Next Week Sunday's Offering is for Harvest House Ministries. Harvest House Ministries was founded on December 1, 1979 by three Christian businessmen, who recognized the need to provide a Christ-centered home for young men struggling with addiction to alcohol and drugs. Harvest House started the Re-Entry program, which was designed to provide graduates with housing and a continued support system, a task that requires more than addiction treatment alone. Skills development has always been a significant part of achieving this goal. Initially started as a wood-working shop in an adjacent farmhouse, the Skills Development program was formalized in 1992 and now includes activities such as salesmanship, meal preparation, carpentry, and administrative work. Harvest House is located in Ottawa.
